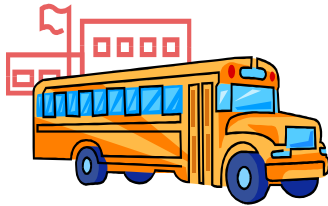

Gehlen Catholic is now offering a federally funded breakfast program. Ala carte items will no longer be available and no cash will be accepted in the lunchroom.

Each day, orange juice, milk, cereal and a choice of fruit are served in addition to the item listed on the school menu. Considered a meal, students will need to choose three items as part of their breakfast. Cost for breakfast (\$1.25/day) for those choosing to enjoy it will be charged to the student’s lunch account.

## Football and Volleyball Game Etiquette

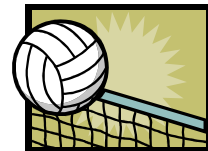
PLEASE...PLEASE....read and follow carefully.

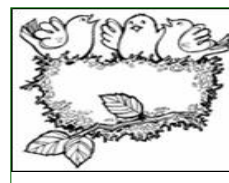
